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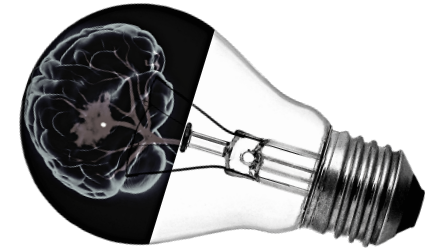

Darryl Toerien serves on the National Committee of the School Libraries Group of CILIP and the Board of the SLA and has recently been elected to the Section Standing Committee for School Libraries of IFLA.

Seymour Papert highlighted that it is impossible to teach students everything that they need to know, so the best we can do is to position them where they can find out what they need to know when they need to know it.

The talk focuses on our efforts to reach this position by design through the development of a Framework Of Skills for Inquiry Learning (FOSIL) and concludes with a consideration of the many and varied benefits of FOSIL, especially to students.

Marelle Rice is a founding member of Philosophy Ireland and is Ireland's leading P4C (Philosophy for Children) trainer

This workshop will give an experiential understanding of Philosophical Inquiry, and explore opportunities to harness it's capacity to engage all learners and build collaborative learning communities in the library setting.
